


Apricot

Prunus armeniaca

Edible
Fruit!

- ☀ Full sun to partial shade
- 💧 Moist, well drained soils
- ↕ 15-30' tall
- ↔ 10-20' wide
- 🌳 Small size at maturity
- Yearly pruning needed
- Self pollinating



Key Features:

Tilton- Small juicy, sweet fruit in summer



Golden Amber- early flowering, ripens into July; great for drying



Montrose- late flowering & fruiting; Small egg sized fruits



Moorpark- reliable producer, juicy fruits, eat fresh or canned



REMEMBER:

- Plant within 1 week of pick up
- Water once a week, 10-20 gallons, from March through December
