





# Staghorn Sumac


*Rhus typhina*

 Full sun to partial shade

 Moist, or dry soils

 15-20' tall

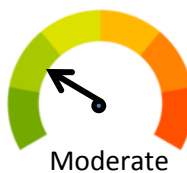
 10-20' wide

 Small size at maturity

— Produces suckers and colonies:

Requires moderate pruning

Maintenance  
Level



## Key Features:

\*Do not mistake this tree for poison sumac (*Toxicodendron vernix*). Staghorn Sumac is not poisonous.\*

Orange/red autumn  
leaves



Red fruit in late  
summer into winter



Hairy leaf  
stems



## REMEMBER:

- Plant within 15 days of pick up
- 20 gallons of water per week from March through December.
