

Tree Delivery and Planting for People with Limited Mobility Application

Thank you for signing up to receive a free yard tree through the TreePhilly Yard Tree Program! If you have limited mobility and cannot pick up and plant your tree, we are offering a free delivery and planting service. There are a limited number of slots available for this service, dependent upon funding, so filling out this application does not guarantee that you will be able to participate. Applicants who receive the free delivery and planting service who are subsequently found to be fraudulent will be billed \$65 for each tree that was delivered and planted.

In addition, you are responsible for all care of the tree after it has been planted. This includes watering the tree 20 gallons every week from March through November of the first two years after planting, mulching the tree twice a year throughout its lifetime, pruning the tree when appropriate, and removal of the tree if needed.
